



Data on Limited English Proficient and Title III Served Students and Subgrantees

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Recent history of Title III data

- NCLB put forth a requirement to produce a “biennial report” on Title III
 - Resulted in a “biennial collection” which was distributed to states in the fall of 2004 and the fall of 2006
 - Title III Biennial Report (T3BR) collection asked for data on both prior school years
 - Collection in 2004 and collection in 2006 were not identical, due to the experience gained in working with 2004 data



Recent history of Title III data

- Collection every two years didn't yield high quality results
 - Data items weren't institutionalized into annual collection items in most states
 - “Previous year” data problem
 - Evolving nature of new Title III requirements made it difficult to provide clarity to states



2006-07 CSPR

- All items needed for the 2009 Title III Biennial regarding the 2006-07 school year were put into Section 1.6 of the CSPR
 - This allowed for the retirement of the separate T3BR collection
 - Some states are not able to report annual on data, due to biennial requirement in the law
 - These states will be able to modify their 2006-07 section 1.6 in the fall of 2008
 - CSPR section 1.6 from 2006-07 and 2007-08 will provide data for the next T3BR



2007-08 CSPR – Proposed Modifications

- 1.6.1- Language Instruction Educational Programs
 - Count of language instruction programs in use and specific languages
- 1.6.2- Student Demographic Data
 - Count of all LEP students and count of Title III served LEP students
 - Most commonly spoken languages
- 1.6.3 – Student Performance Data
 - Count of all LEP students assessed in annual English language proficiency assessment
 - Results of all LEP students assessed (# and % proficient and above)
 - Count of all Title III served LEP students assessed in annual English language proficiency assessment
 - Results of all Title III LEP students assessed (“Making Progress and “Attainment”)
 - Native Language Assessments (Does the state use them? In which languages?)
 - Monitored former LEP students (Number in Year 1 and Year 2, and proficiency results for all MFLEP in math, reading and science)



2007-08 CSPR – Proposed Modifications

- 1.6.4- Title III Subgrantees
 - Number of subgrantees
 - Number making each AMAO (and making all AMAOs)
 - Number not making AMAOs for 2 consecutive years
 - State AMAO determinations
 - Count of terminated Title III programs
- 1.6.5- Education Programs for Immigrant Students
 - Count of immigrant students and immigrant students in 3114(d)(1) programs
- 1.6.6 – Teachers and Professional Development
 - Count of certified/licensed teachers working in Title III programs
 - Count of subgrantees offering specific professional development topics
 - Count of subgrantees and participants receiving PD activities
- 1.6.7 – State Subgrant Activities
 - Date and count of days to distribute Title III allocation
