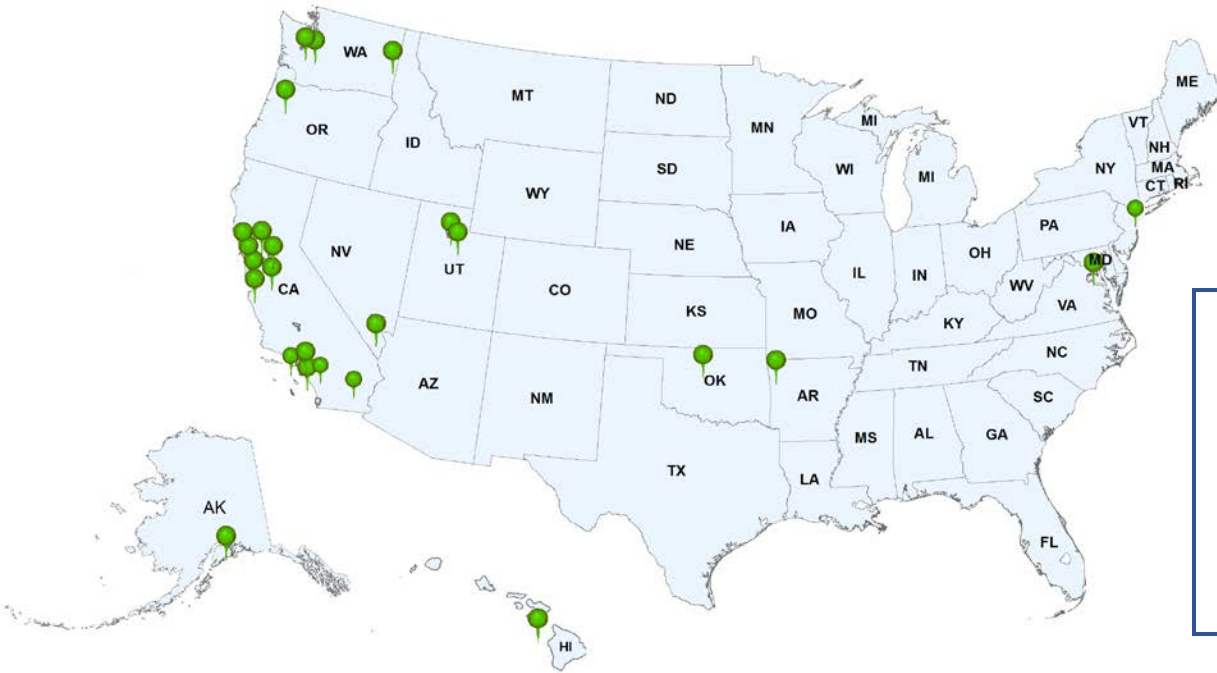

### LEAs With the Largest Number of ELs Who Are NHPI

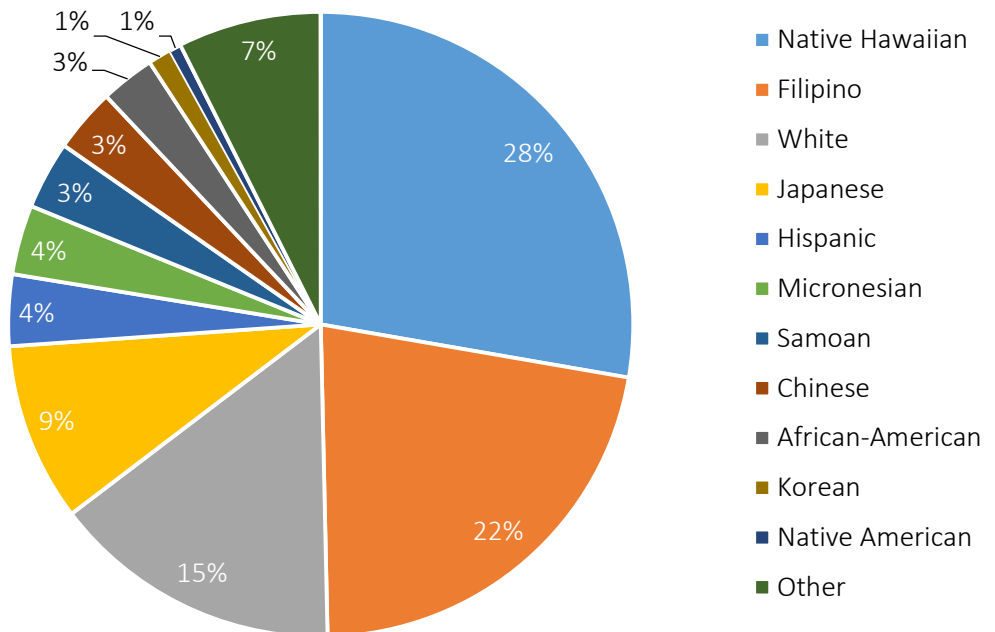
