Addressing the Needs of the Educator Workforce for English Learners

This expert seminar will provide a brief overview of a recent study from the National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine, *Promoting the Educational Success of Children and Youth Learning English*, that examines what research reveals about learning English from early childhood through high school. One of the study's editors, Ruby Takanishi, Ph.D., will focus on conclusions and recommendations from this report on how to build the workforce to educate English learners. The seminar will include an overview of the demographics of the current workforce; policies and certification requirements; and issues related to the preparation, recruitment, and retention of the educator workforce.
