

Summary of FY 2007 and 2008 Attachment T Findings and Conditions on State Title III, Part A Grant Awards

FY 2007

- 27 States received a grant award with an Attachment T
- 8 States received a grant award with conditions
- 19 States received a grant award with special conditions

Status of FY 2007 Attachment Ts

- 24 States implemented acceptable corrective actions
- 3 States have findings and conditions that were continued in FY 2008

FY 2008

- 19 States received grant awards with Attachment T conditions

Major Findings in FY 2007 and FY 2008

Attachment T Findings and Conditions in FY 2007 and 2008 addressed statutory requirements for States to:

- Make Title III annual measurable achievement objectives (AMAOs) determinations for all Title III subgrantees;
- Notify Title III subgrantees if they did not meet Title III AMAOs;
- Ensure that Title III subgrantees that did not meet Title III AMAOs notify parents;
- Ensure that all LEP students in grades K-12 are administered an annual ELP assessment in all domains;
- Align English language proficiency (ELP) assessments to ELP standards;
- Align ELP standards to the achievement of State academic content and student academic achievement standards; and
- Submit all required data and information in the annual Consolidated State Performance Report on the performance of Title III subgrantees in meeting AMAOs and achievement results for LEP students making progress in learning English and attaining English proficiency.
