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

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# NUMBER OF ELs, BY STATE, INCLUDING DC: SY 2015-16







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

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# NAEP 4<sup>TH</sup> GRADE READING SCORES; ELs AND NON-ELs BY RACE/ETHNICITY: SY 2015





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# NAEP 8<sup>TH</sup> GRADE READING SCORES FOR ELs AND NON-ELs, BY RACE/ETHNICITY: 2015





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# NAEP 4<sup>TH</sup> GRADE MATH SCORES; ELs AND NON-ELs BY RACE/ETHNICITY: SY 2015





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



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## Number of States Offering a Seal of Biliteracy: 2011-2017





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
# PERCENTAGE OF ELs ENROLLED AND PARTICIPATED IN COLLEGE AND CAREER READINESS (CCR)



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# HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION RATES BY STUDENT GROUP: SY 2014-15












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# ALL OELA DISCRETIONARY GRANTS BY STATE: 2016





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# NATIVE AMERICAN ALASKA NATIVE CHILDREN IN SCHOOL GRANTS (NAM) BY STATE: 2016




