**DID YOU KNOW?**

- Forsyth County Schools has 42 elementary schools, 15 middle schools, 11 high schools and twelve special schools. It is the fifth-largest system in North Carolina and the 83rd largest in the nation.
- District wide, 43.6% of the students are White, 29.2% are African-American, 20.6% are Hispanic, 4.0% are Multiracial, 2.3 % are Asian, and less than 1 % are American Indian or Native Hawaiians/Pacific.
