DID YOU KNOW?

- New Hampshire serves 197,140 students in 494 schools in 280 school districts, almost two-thirds of which are considered “rural.”
- School districts in New Hampshire offer English-based programs to serve the educational needs of EL students.
- New Hampshire’s dropout rate is currently 1.19 %, which is one of the lowest dropout rates in the nation.
